Introduction

The College Annual Action Plan (CAAP) is Champlain's main planning document for the 2007-2008 academic year and consists of goals and actions grouped under eight areas:

- Area 1: Clarifying Institutional Mission
- Area 2: Facilitating and Enhancing Student Success
- Area 3: Developing and Improving Academic Programs
- Area 4: Maintaining and Increasing Student Enrolment
- Area 5: Maintaining and Developing Human Resources
- Area 6: Operational Priorities for the Current Year
- Area 7: Institutional Planning and Communications
- Area 8: Strengthening Enrolment and Retention at Champlain Lennoxville

Each of these areas is further divided into one or more subareas. The first five of these areas, along with their constituent subareas, are based directly on the Strategic Issues and Subissues identified in the 2004-2008 Strategic Action Plan (SAP). For these five areas, the CAAP includes all strategic actions scheduled to take place during the 2007-2008 academic year. Thus, the Strategic Action Plan provides the foundation for the CAAP. The three remaining areas, along with their constituent subareas, provide a framework for organizing goals and actions that reflect the College's other priorities during the 2007-2008 academic year.

This Executive Summary presents information on all of the goals contained in the CAAP for 2007-2008. The timelines for each goal are based on the earliest start date of any action associated with that goal and the latest finish date.
